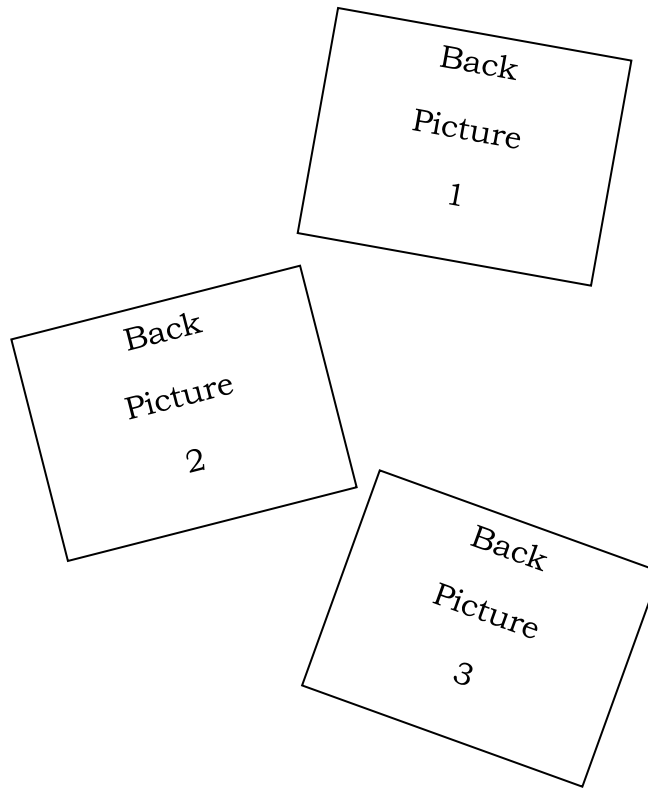


About CCA and Staff

The CCA Preschool

- Serving families in DeKalb, Sycamore, and surrounding areas.
 - CCA provides a nondenominational, Christ-centered academic program committed to excellence.
 - A carefully supervised and balanced program offered to children 3, 4, and 5 years.
 - Early morning care (6:30—8:30 a.m.) and after school care (3:00-6:00 p.m.) is available for pre-school children for an additional charge and is billed monthly.
 - The ABeka curriculum is primarily used with teachers supplementing age appropriate teaching materials. Guest speakers are also incorporated into various lessons.
 - Each class has music and library time, gym class, sign language skills, and basic Spanish.
 - CCA offers various payment options. We also accept 4-C payments
- A nutritious hot lunch is provided for children enrolled in the full day program.
 - Morning session begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 11:30 a.m.
 - Full day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m.
 - Special programs are held including orientation, monthly chapels, Thanksgiving festival, Christmas musical, winter fair, Spring Sing/Art Fair, Pre-K graduation ceremony, field trips, and holiday parties.

3 Year Old Class:

The Christian based ABeka curriculum will be introduced in this class to teach the children phonics and numbers. This daily program uses Biblical themes which incorporate music, science, art, and stories into their daily schedule. This class provides a structured and nurturing environment for the children. They also learn through hands-on experiences and learning centers. The children are introduced to Spanish and sign language. We welcome all children three years old that are fully toilet trained.

3-1/2 - 4 Year Old Class:

ABeka curriculum is also used in this class to teach the children phonics and numbers. Spanish, sign language, and Bible lessons are also part of their day. Fun activities are used to help motivate the children's knowledge of the world around them. Classroom themes are used to incorporate science and art.

Pre-K Class:

The Pre-K class is designed for children ages four and five years of age who will be entering kindergarten the following year. Using the ABeka curriculum, this class will challenge children with the concept of numbers, writing upper and lower case letters, learning the sounds of vowels and consonants, and the ability to blend those sounds. They also learn numerical sequence and value. The children will increase their knowledge of Spanish, sign language, and science. Music and art are also part of their day. This class allows the children to grow and mature as they prepare for kindergarten.
